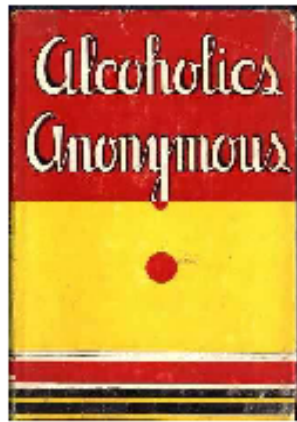

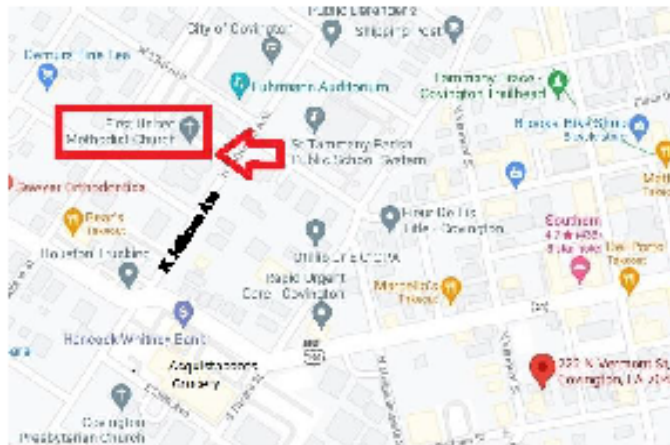
This workshop will emphasize *taking* these steps so one can start living this program of recovery.

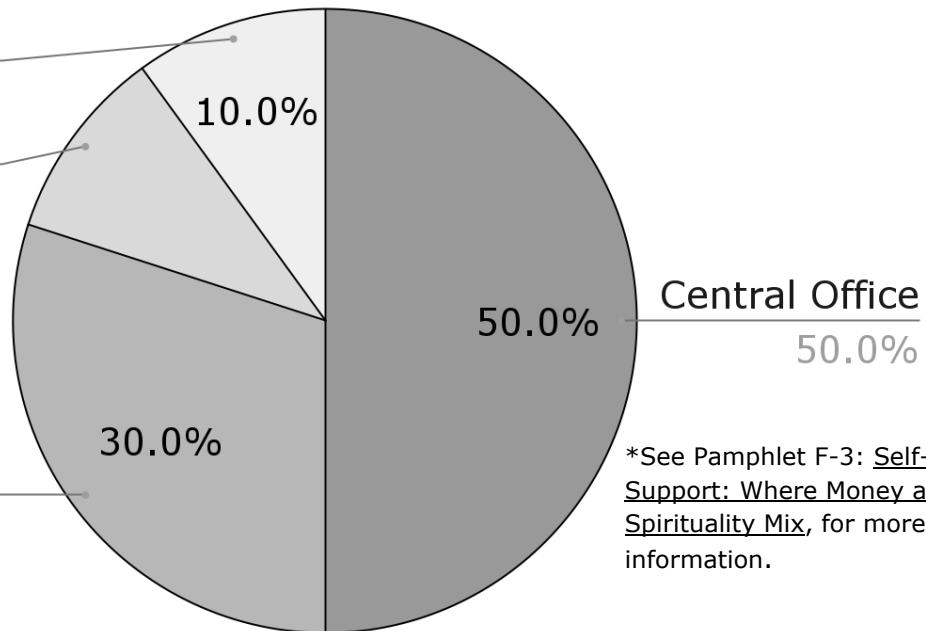
