The Service Board ad hoc committee welcomes questions, comments and suggestions to the proposed amendments to the bylaws. Please submit these by Monday, March 22 to our Vice-Chair, Anthony A. (anthony@roubioninc.com / 248.763.4338). Our 3/25 Service Board meeting will host the final discussion and approval of the proposed amendments and all are welcome to attend and share their thoughts. The Ad Hoc committee will consider all ideas and present the finalized proposed amendments in the April and May bulletins to be voted on in the May "Special" Service Board meeting on 5/25/21.

Summary of Proposed Amendments to the GNOSB By Laws February 2021

- **Trustees will be permitted to vote, excluding the chairperson**
- **Voting service board members include: Secretary, Vice-Chair, Treasurer, DCMs, Committee Chairs, Central Office Manager, Group Service Board Representatives**
- **Categorize the Treasurer position as a Trustee**
- **Shift the month in which the annual elections of trustees take place from June to May to create an on-boarding period**
- **Adjust required sobriety time to suggested sobriety time**
- **Add 2 year suggested term limit for the Treasurer position**
- **Increase maximum financial contribution (donation) from \$3,000 to \$5,000 per updated AA guidelines**
- **Add-in order to disperse of funds in emergency situations, the Chair must:**
 - **Consult with the Trustees**
 - **Obtain the approval of at least one other Trustee**
- **Add that substantial unanimity will be required in order to dissolve the GNOSB**
